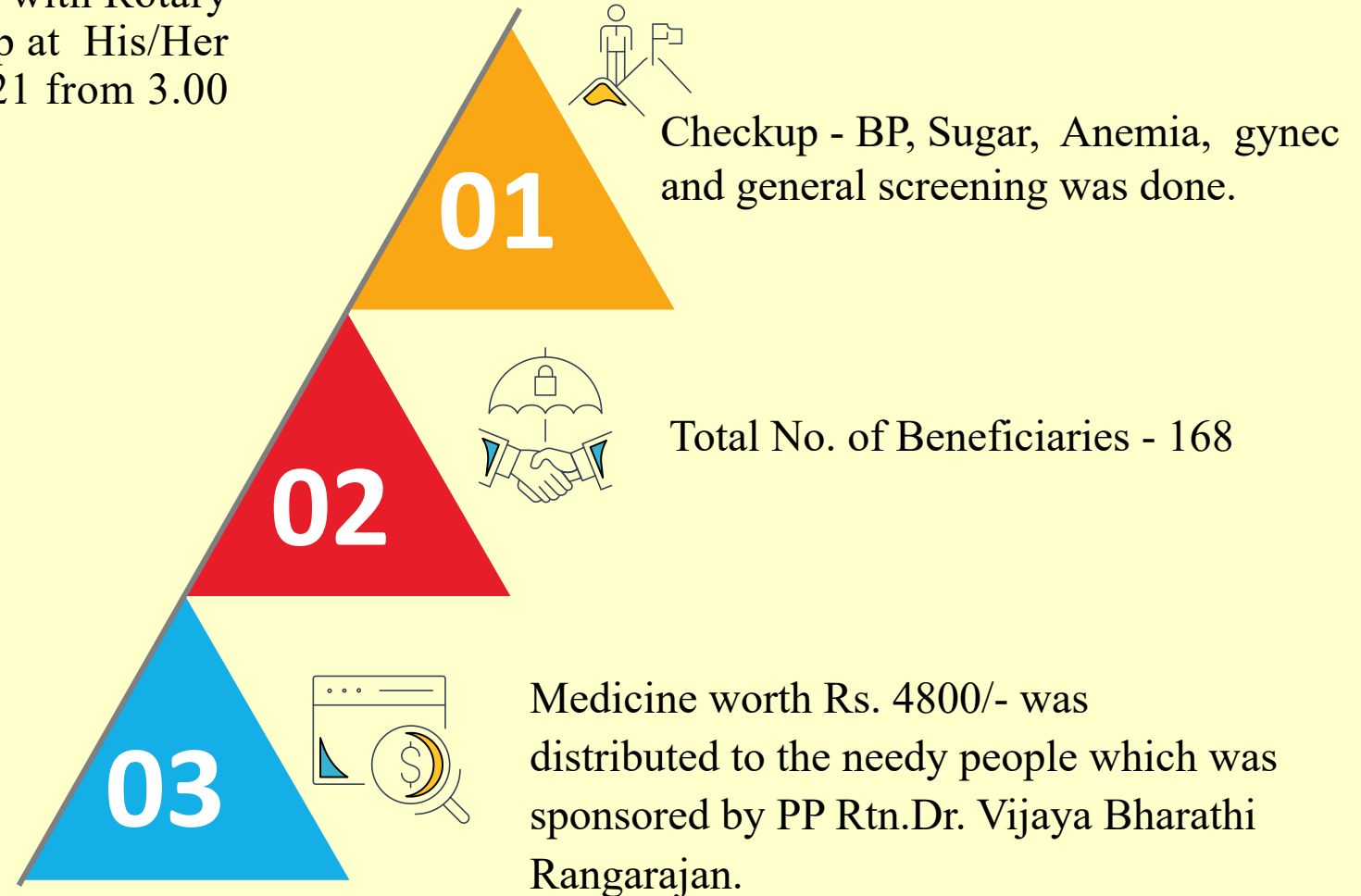



NUTRITION PROJECT

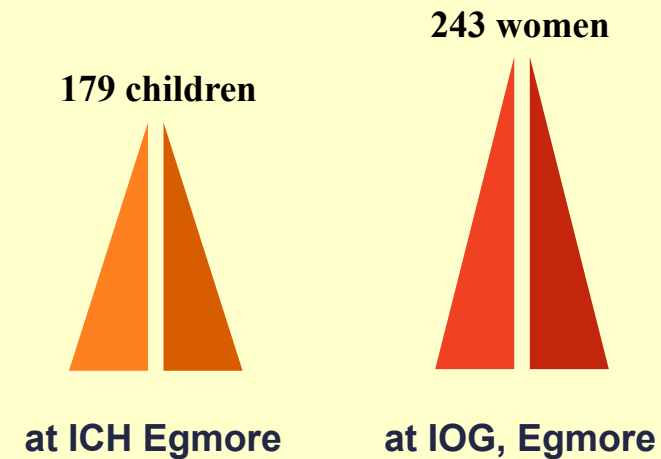
CANSTOP conducts its Nutrition Project in Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and at Institute of Child Health Hospital for Children.
