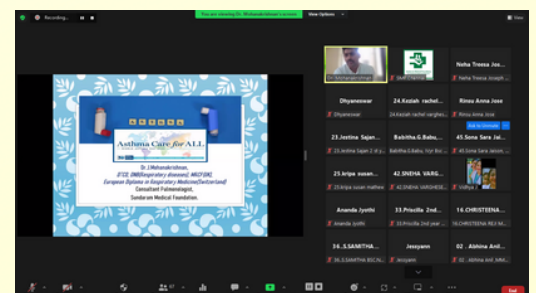
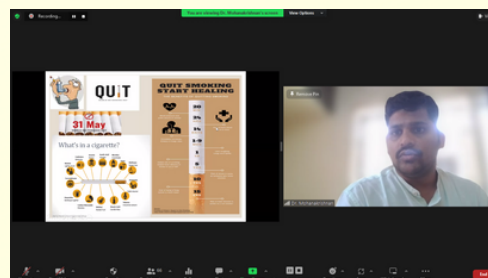


## STEP PROGRAMME

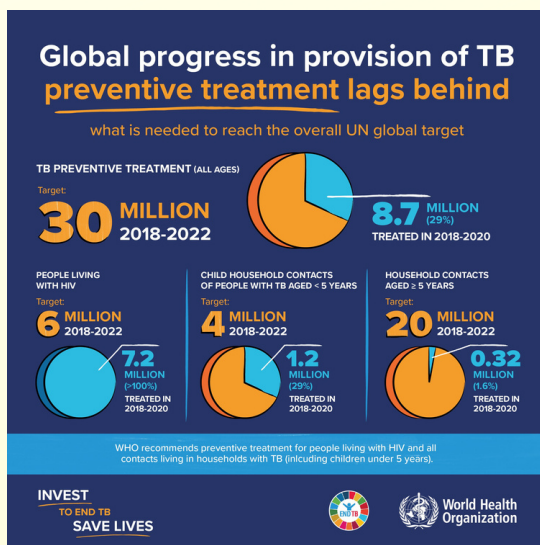

# CANCER AWARENESS TALK

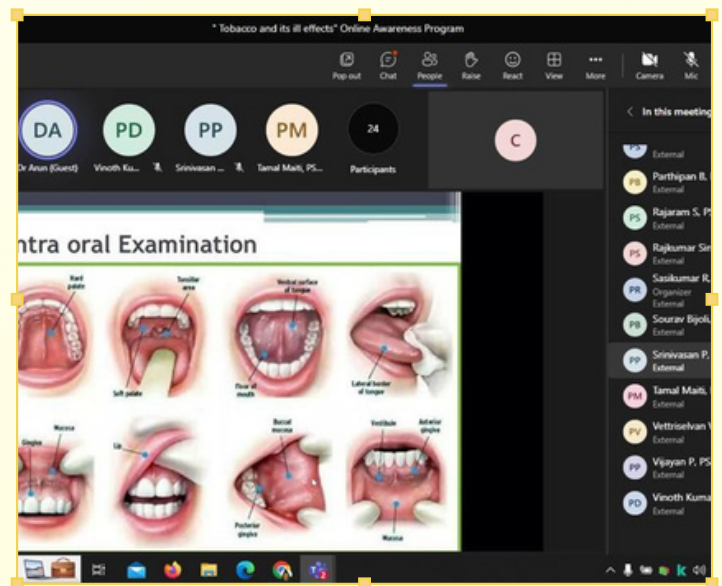
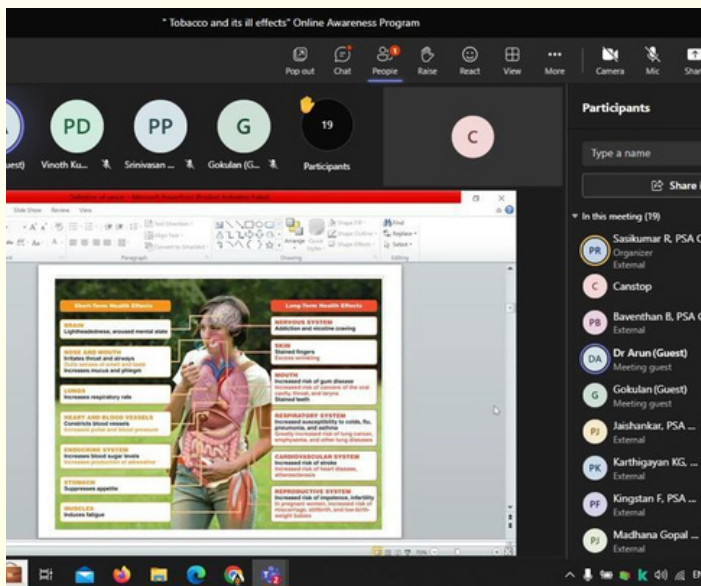

3rd Place - Pratik K

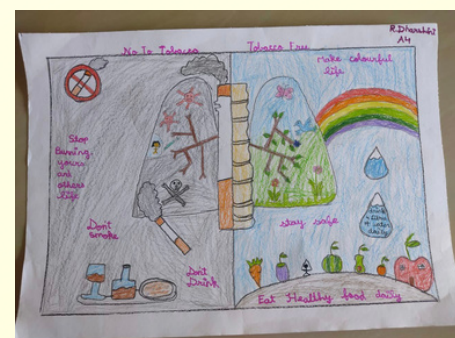
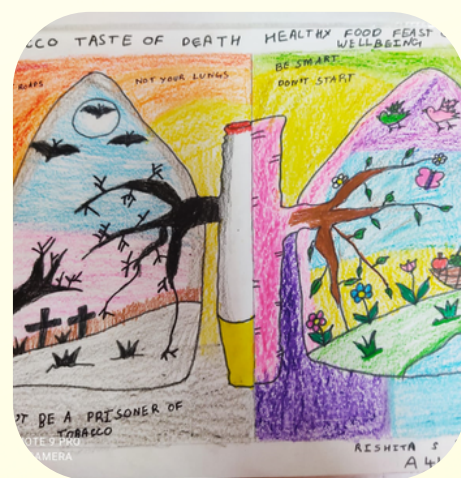
Category 11 to 15 yrs:

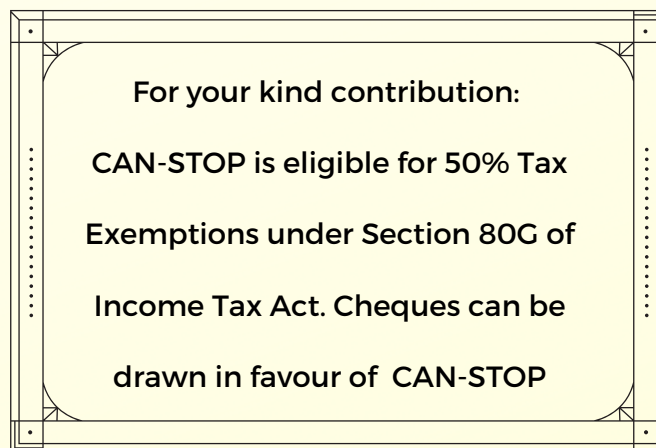
